



<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. <i>The equipment manufactured has not been modified or varied from the original, tested prototype or specimen;</i>2. <i>The equipment displays the date of manufacture and date of next service; the number of persons it is certified to carry and the following wording:- "Approved for use on licensed vessels less than 25GT and pleasure vessels under 100GT";</i>3. <i>the equipment has clear and concise instructions for launching procedure and in the case of raft packed in a valise, an instruction card encased in clear durable material,</i>4. <i>the equipment contained within the raft is according to SAMSA policy and guidelines and SAMSA approved (small vessel pack and the appropriate warning on the outside of the container);</i>5. <i>the equipment remains fit for use whilst in service;</i>6. <i>and the life raft and equipment are serviced by an authorized life raft service station.</i>	
This certificate remains valid until the date stated hereon, unless canceled or revoked by the Authority, which may withdraw this approval at any time for reasons of non-compliance with the applicable regulations referred to in this Certificate of Approval	
It is the responsibility of the manufacturer to notify the Authority of any modifications or changes to the equipment to ensure the continued validity of this certificate.
